

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE SNIPVERSE COMMUNITY

Governance Charter of the Keep Snipping Token (KSTO)

Version 1.2

Adopted February 2026

PREAMBLE

We, the members and holders participating in the Snipverse ecosystem, establish this Constitution to define the principles, governance structure, and economic stewardship standards guiding the Keep Snipping Token (KSTO).

This Constitution exists to promote integrity, transparency, structured participation, and long-term sustainability within the Snipverse ecosystem operating on the XPR Network.

ARTICLE I – CORE VALUES

Section 1. Integrity and Authenticity.

All participants shall act in good faith, with honesty, and with transparency in all ecosystem interactions.

Section 2. Respect and Conduct.

Members shall engage respectfully. Harassment, abuse, or deliberate harm to other participants is prohibited.

Section 3. Participation.

Active engagement in governance and ecosystem initiatives is encouraged to strengthen alignment and sustainability.

ARTICLE II – ECONOMIC STEWARDSHIP

Section 1. Responsible Participation.

Participants are encouraged to act responsibly in token-related activities to promote ecosystem stability.

Section 2. Voluntary Standard.

Nothing in this Article restricts lawful market activity. These provisions reflect voluntary community standards of responsible participation.

ARTICLE III – TRANSPARENCY AND GOVERNANCE

Section 1. Leadership Accountability.

Founders and contributors shall communicate material ecosystem decisions transparently through official channels.

Section 2. Governance Framework.

Voting mechanics, quorum thresholds, proposal procedures, and binding authority shall be defined in a separate Governance Framework document.

Section 3. Due Process.

Alleged violations of community standards shall be reviewed through a documented and fair process.

ARTICLE IV – ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement actions may include warnings, temporary suspension from community channels, or governance restrictions, as determined by designated governance moderators.

ARTICLE V – TREASURY RESPONSIBILITY

The community treasury shall be managed with transparency and subject to governance oversight. Material treasury reallocations shall require defined governance approval mechanisms.

ARTICLE VI – AMENDMENTS

This Constitution may be amended through public proposal, open discussion, and defined voting thresholds as outlined in the Governance Framework.

ARTICLE VII – GOVERNANCE AUTHORITY

Governance authority shall transition to DAO-based governance according to the published governance framework.

ARTICLE VIII – LIMITATION

This Constitution establishes governance standards within the Snipverse ecosystem and does not constitute a legally binding contract, partnership agreement, or financial instrument.

RATIFICATION

This Constitution becomes effective upon public publication and community adoption.
